



SPORTS CAMP PROCEDURES - COVID-19

Next Level Sports Ltd has developed a rigorous Risk Assessment based on government guidelines for all camp venues. We are also working alongside all schools to ensure we follow suitable and achievable procedures already put in place.

Next Level Sports Ltd will be following all constantly checking and adhering to all government guidelines prior and throughout the camps taking place.

Next Level Sports Ltd have developed sport and activity plans (following the guidance from the AfPE) to ensure all guidelines and social distancing is maintained throughout all activities. Next Level Sports Ltd will inform all parents of our signing in and collection procedure by email prior to the camp taking place.

If your child or anybody is showing COVID-19 symptoms (listed on www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/symptoms) Please keep your child at home and follow the self isolation guidelines.

If Next Level Sports Ltd suspects any child to be showing COVID-19 symptoms during camp, they will be placed in an isolated room and the parent will have to collect the child immediately.

If there is any suspected cases during our camp, all parents will be informed immediately and we reserve the right to cancel the camps on any dates proposed. Information on refunds will be discussed with the parents in that case.

Next Level Sports Ltd will adhere to follow the cleaning guidelines of equipment as recommended by the AfPE. The venues of sports camps (schools) will be maintained and clean by school site managers, following their own guidelines.

During the Summer 2020 camps, only 1 adult will be allowed to drop off and collect their child each day. If you are paying by cash, the exact monies must be placed in a sealed envelope and handed in on registration. No change can be provided.

Parents will be expected to follow the drop off and collection guidelines set out in each school, which will be signposted.

Children who are not following the rules stated and whom put other children's health at risk will be asked to be collected immediately by the parent and Next Level Sports Ltd reserves the right to exclude the camp for the current season.

No refund will be provided Children are asked not to bring any equipment from home, only their lunch boxes, water bottles and additional clothing needed (and any medical equipment- inhalers, epipens). Parents are requested to wipe/clean these items with disinfectant before arriving at the camp.

Next Level Sports Ltd reserves the right to clean any of these items using our own products. Children will not be able to arrive and attend on the day without prior booking. Booking must be made by midnight of day before the day they wish to attend.

This will be asked when completing your booking details online All Next Level Sports Ltd camp coaches have completed the covid-19 Prevent training and personal certificates will be carried by each coach. Next Level Sports Ltd reserves the right to administer first aid without wearing PPE equipment, as advised.

Any coach suspected of COVID-19 symptoms will be sent home immediately and replaced by an alternative coach. Parents will be informed. Next Level Sports Ltd reserve the right to cancel the camp at any time and parents will be contacted if we feel its in the interest of the health of the children and adults in school.
